Equipment requested by Nkawkaw included an ECG machine, Spirometer, Hand-held oximeter, Stethoscopes and Sphygmomanometers. Our objective was to fundraise as much as possible towards meeting the request. Many of our guests had first-hand experience on the use of ECG machines, oximeters and Spirometers, so personally knew the benefits.

A raffle assisted our fundraising, and generous donations were made from local businesses – Leaf Creative donated a large Hosta plant, Glasshouse Inn donated and in addition two meal vouchers and a local beautician a voucher for a treatment.



On display to further interest in the event were WW2 reenactors Vicky and Philip Lambert, who dressed in Home Guard outfits displayed and spoke about their knowledge of UK guns and munitions through to 1940's, and American medical equipment – not so different from instruments used today!
