5. **PLEASE NOTE THAT** to ensure integrity of the process every returned ballot would have identity information of the voter, **to be valid**. This is to ensure that no-one votes twice.
 - However, these identifiers would be removed by the electoral officer once the received ballot had been checked against the membership list.
